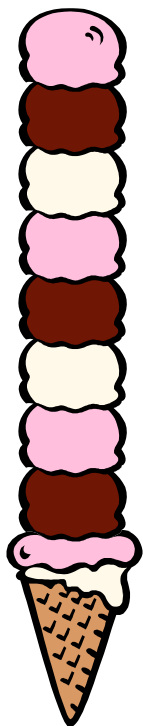

Be an O.P.T.I.O.N.S. Leader and...

- Teach a group of kids to play chess
- Supervise a room of board games
- Show kids how to fold a paper airplane and hold a flight contest
- Teach a class on photography, cooking, sewing, pet care, or money management
- Explore what to do in case of natural or man-made disasters (could use history tie-ins)
- Imagine a world tour and introduce kids to a different country/culture
- Lead a creative craft project of your choice
- Bring your Legos and organize a challenge (building contest, robots, etc.)
- Help kids explore fascination with weather
- Get kids moving with fun dance steps
- Introduce kids to music (guitar, karaoke, etc.)
- Be theatrical with stand-up comedy and help kids think fast on their feet
- Teach chemistry with a simple recipe
- Be a computer detective and help kids take things apart to see what goes on inside.
